### FUND BACKGROUND

## WHAT IS THE JOURNALISM FUTURES FUND?

- The Journalism Futures Fund is a funding collaboration between foundations and individual donors in Canada.
- Its mission is to support independent journalism that strengthens civic life and democracy by investing in journalistic excellence, equity and financial sustainability.
- The Fund prioritizes organizations that serve and are led by members of communities that are underrepresented in newsroom leadership and under-served in news coverage.


## HOW DO YOU DEFINE 'UNDERSERVED COMMUNITIES'?

- Communities that are underrepresented in newsroom leadership and frequently overlooked or misrepresented in media.
- Includes but not limited to:
  - Black and other racialized communities;
  - Indigenous Peoples (First Nations, Inuit and Métis);
  - o newcomers, migrant workers, refugees and asylum-seekers;
  - low-income communities;
  - 2SLGBTQIA+ people;
  - opeople with disabilities;
  - o and those located in Northern, rural or remote areas.

#### FUND GOALS

O1. Build Canada's first collaborative model for journalism philanthropy, raising an initial pool of \$8M by summer 2029.

O2. Strengthen the operational and financial resilience of independent media led by individuals from underserved communities in Canadian journalism.

O3. Grow the leadership and influence of senior editors and publishers from historically underserved communities.



## FUNDING MODEL

#### THE JFF MODEL

Organizational funding:

Multi-year grants to strengthen the operational resilience of small and medium journalism organizations.

Project-based funding:

Grants for projects led by one or more organizations (details to be announced in 2026).

Capacity strengthening support:

Tailored support focused primarily on improving operational and financial resilience.



# OPEN NOW: ORGANIZATIONAL FUNDING STREAM

## 2025 ORGANIZATIONAL FUNDING ROUND

- Two to seven organizations will receive <u>three-year</u> grants of \$50,000-\$200,000 per year, paired with capacity-strengthening support.
- This support is meant to help great organizations get stronger and take the next step in their growth, whatever that looks like for them.

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Eligible organizations must:
  - be incorporated and conduct activities in Canada
  - oproduce original journalism in English or French
  - be independent, meaning not a government outlet or owned or governed by a publicly-traded company, advocacy group, religious group, political party, hedge fund or private equity firm
  - o adhere to journalistic ethics guidelines

#### PRIORITY ORGANIZATIONS

The Fund prioritizes journalism organizations that are:

#### **Established:**

More than a year in operation: not a fund for startups.

#### **Small to medium:**

1-10 staff and under \$1M budget

#### Leadership\*:

By individuals from communities underserved in Canadian media

\* Leadership refers to the individuals who make decisions about the organization's editorial line, operations and governance.

#### EVALUATION CRITERIA

1. Community listening: A commitment to meeting the information needs of the organization's audiences.


**2. Journalistic impact:** A track record of journalism that meaningfully affects the lives of the audiences served.

- 3. Representative leadership: Decision-makers from communities that are underserved in media.
- **4. Sustainability planning:** An intention to strengthen the organization's journalistic impact, operational resilience and financial health.

#### APPLICATION PROCESS



#### INTRODUCTORY APPLICATION

- 3. About you: 12 questions

  - Your Goals
  - 2 Work Samples

Submitted via application portal. Estimated time: 2-3 hours.

#### FULL APPLICATION

Full application includes additional information about:

- Leadership & Decision-Making
- Audiences & Community Listening
- Finances
- Organizational Development & Planning

Invited applicants will receive an **honoraria** to support preparation.

The Fund team will be available to support.

#### **ELIGIBLE EXPENSES**

- Salaries and benefits for employees (full-time and part-time)
- Professional fees and expenses
- Meetings and events
- Travel and accommodation within Canada
- Training and education fees
- Administration up to 10% of the budget (e.g., office rent, general accounting, software, IT systems, telecommunications)

\*All expenses must support the production and advancement of independent journalism

#### INELIGIBLE EXPENSES\*

- Capital projects and purchases (e.g., real estate, vehicles)
- Supplies and equipment (e.g., office equipment, IT hardware, machinery)
- Endowments or investment vehicles
- Debt repayments
- Retroactive funding
- Academic research, tuition, bursaries or scholarships
- General fundraising efforts, capital campaigns or sponsorships
- Personal appeals (for financial support)

<sup>\*</sup>In addition to any expenses that do not meet basic eligibility
